### Music Note

John Taverner, not to be confused with 20th Century composer John Tavener, was the first director of music at Christ Church Oxford in 1526. There he wrote some of the finest polyphonic music that would endure across half a millennium. His setting of *Sicut Anima Mea* comprises the second part of his motet, *Quemadmodum*, which is a setting of the first verses of Psalm 42: "my soul is athirst for God, yea even for the living God." The theme of water is present through much of the music of the day, from the same psalm set by Palestrina at 9:00am, to the ecstatic awe at the beauty of creation in Rachmaninov's *Blagoslovi Duche Moya* (from his 1915 setting of the Vespers) sung at 4:00pm. Do mark your calendars for an exciting opportunity to support the next generation of composers in our public workshop on Thursday January 24 at 5:45pm. The Cathedral Choir will be rehearsing and recording two new works by competition finalists from the University of Toronto, Hanna Kim and Benjamin Gabbay. The open session will last until around 8:00pm, as we give an inside view into how choral music is made from manuscript to first performance.
