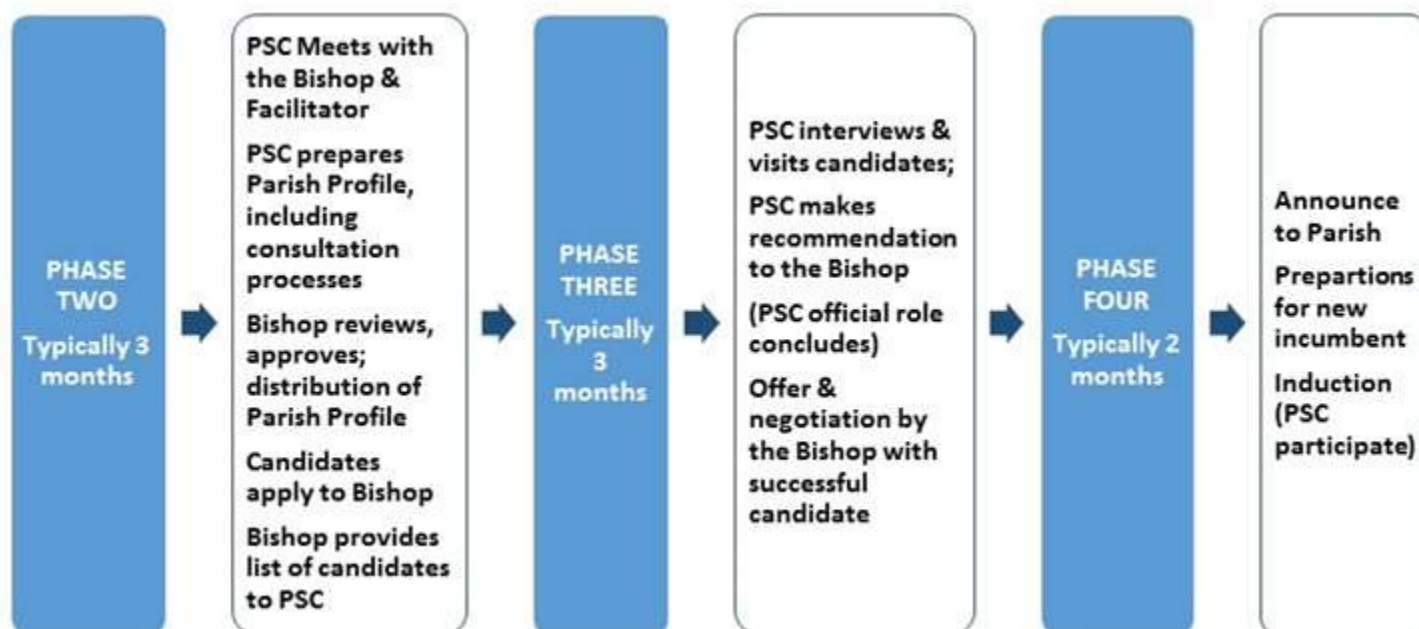

An Anniversary Year 1797-2022 - Did You Know?



In the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, it was customary for well-to-do families to own or rent their own pews in the church they attended. The Cathedral Archives contain a list of pew owners at St. James dating from 1803. Although this practice was discontinued, you can still find traces of it: several plaques remain in the pews, and one of them notes it was for the Gooderham Family.
