CALGARY, ALBERTA

Over 400 Anglicans and Lutherans gathered in Calgary from June 27 – July 2 for *Assembly* and for the 43rd General Synod of the Anglican Church of Canada. For the second time (the last one being in 2013) the **Assembly** brought together our General Synod and the National Convention of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada together to mark our now two decade plus long full-communion relationship and to welcome and affirm the Moravian Church of North America as our new full-communion partners, as they are with both The Episcopal Church (USA) and The Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Like all church-wide gatherings, General Synod had its share of ups and downs, but the opportunity to gather together with our Lutheran brothers and sisters was wonderful!
