



#### FINANCIAL UPDATE – Q3 2024





We have almost achieved our donations budget by the end of Q3, thanks to our faithful and generous supporters who have donated this year. The numerous gifts and pledges we received during our recent Stewardship Campaign are an encouraging message to us that we can count on you to provide for the ministry and its operating needs.
