Full Communion & Shared Resources







At the 2001 meeting of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Canada in Waterloo, the signing of the document "Called to Full Communion" (The Waterloo Declaration), marked the start of a Full Communion relationship with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC). Last June in Calgary, these two synods with the Northern Province of the Moravian Church in America (including Canada) signed "One Flock, One Shepherd: Lutherans, Anglicans, and Moravians—Called to Walk Together in Full Communion" (The Moravian Declaration) to establish their full communion relationship. This relationship means that the three churches may welcome all ordained ministers to serve in the ministry of the other, consult on ministry issues, establish collegial and conciliar consultation of matters of faith, and share authorized liturgical resources, among other things. With this in mind, our cathedral has been using Lutheran Eucharistic Prayers and the version of the Moravian Lord's Prayer in our services. 
Join our Stewardship Campaign before November 11 – Last Call
