

The Feast of Christ the King

On this last Sunday of the church year, we are looking backward and forward. It is something akin to standing on a threshold! We look back over the completed story of the public ministry of Jesus as we have followed him from Christmas to Holy Week, to Easter to Ascension and Pentecost and now this week we celebrate the Reign of Christ. The year that began with anticipation and the hope of the coming Messiah ends with the proclamation of God's sovereignty!

That progression is relatively familiar. What is perhaps less familiar is that the end of the church year is principally the season of looking forward – forward to the second coming, the consummation of God's Kingdom on earth, and the reign of Christ. Our Gospel readings for the past few weeks have certainly unscored that!

And now this week we are at a turning point as we prepare to travel together through the 4-week season of Advent. Advent means *coming*. It is a time of hope-filled anticipation – *Come, Lord Jesus* we will pray! But let's remember that we stand on the horizon of God's future not merely as observers or as people waiting passively, but active partners in making known God's work of healing, reconciliation, justice, and peace-making.

Our gospel text imagines the time when the realm of God is fulfilled on earth - and it summons us into a way of living, a way of being in the world, now:

Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me. Matthew 25.34-36

I cannot imagine a more relevant gospel text for FaithWorks Sunday!


Christmas Memorial Flowers
