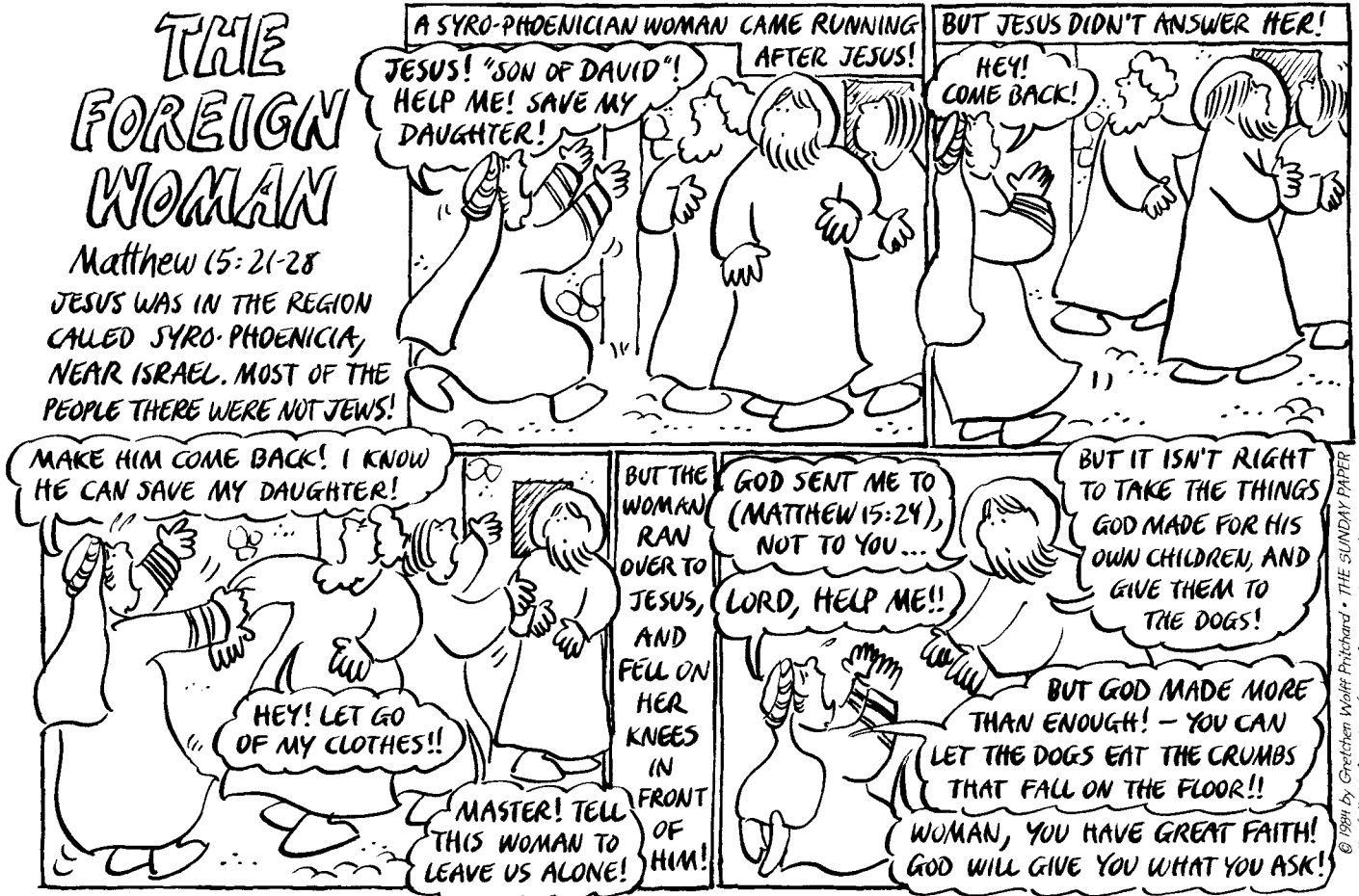

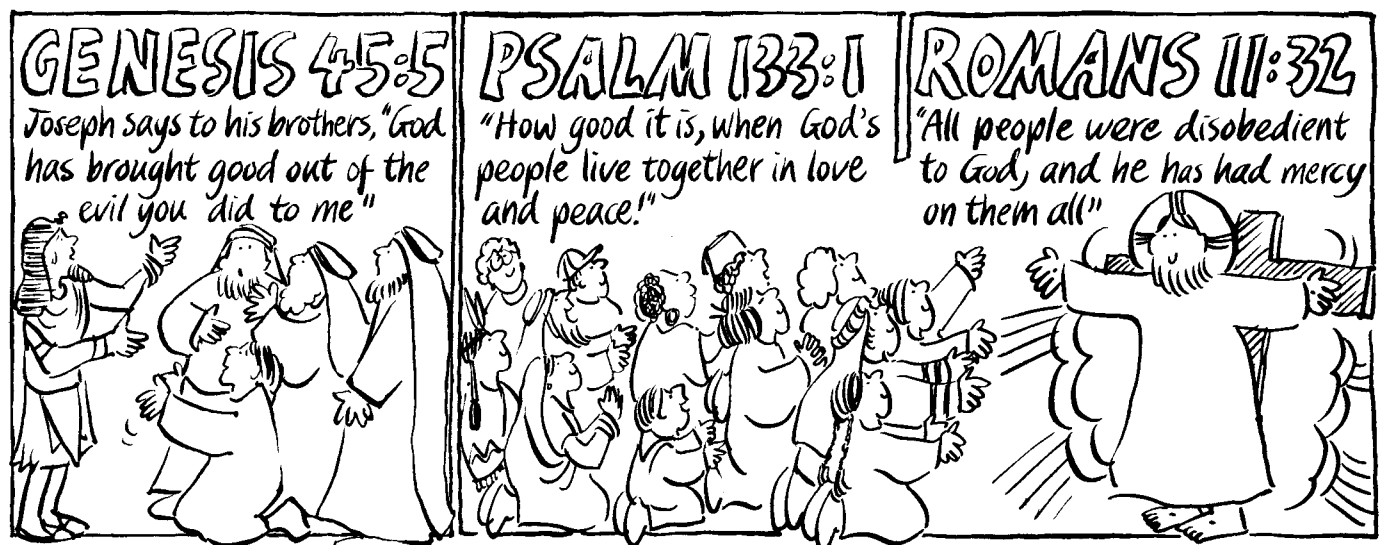
## THE FOREIGN WOMAN
