“Merry Moments” returns to St. James!

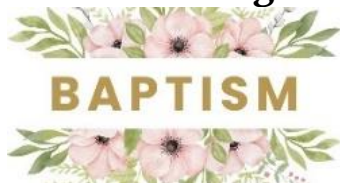

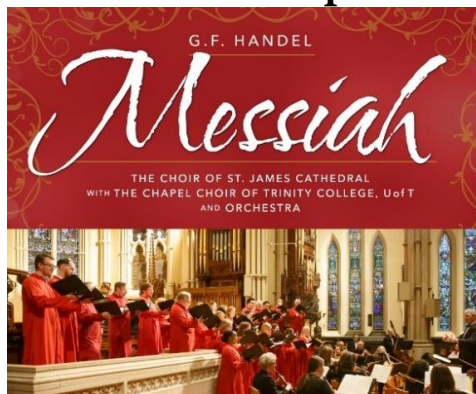
